What is a Hoosier Knight's stake in Gibault?

Created as a Gift to Indiana

Did you know...the first step for creating Gibault began at the 1915 State Convention of the Indiana Knights of Columbus? It was decided then the Knights of Columbus would establish a home for delinquent boys as a contribution of the Catholic people of Indiana for the State's Centennial Celebration of 1916.

This gift, given by Hoosier Knights, has helped more than 10,350 children learn to lead happier and healthier lives.

Did you know...Hoosier Knights continue to govern Gibault?

Did you know...of the 20 members of the Gibault Board of Trustees that 17 are Knights of Columbus? The Board also has 6 Past State Deputies, our current Worthy State Deputy, Paul Zielinski and all State Officers serve as special attendees on committees and help to guide our mission.

Did you know...each year according to Gibault's By-laws, the members present at the State Convention elect 3 members to serve on Gibault's Board of Trustees for a 3-year term? This ensures that 9 members at any given time are elected by Hoosier Knights.

Did you know...according to the Gibault By-Laws, Article XIX, in the event Gibault ceases, terminates or discontinues doing business, the assets of Gibault shall be transferred to the Indiana State Council Knights of Columbus or one of its affiliates?

Did you know...Gibault Board of Trustees approve Gibault's annual budget, hire and evaluate the CEO and ensure proper policy is in place to keep Gibault operational?

So what does all this mean?

This means Hoosier Knights conceived and gave life to Gibault. This means Hoosier Knights govern and direct Gibault. Gibault is not just the 'Number One Charity' of the Indiana Knights of Columbus...it is a **part** of the Indiana Knights of Columbus.
